Malaysia Technical Cooperation Programme (MTCP)

MTCP was first initiated at the 1st Commonwealth Heads of Government Regional Meeting (CHOGRM) for Asia Pacific Region held in Sydney in February 1978. It was officially launched on 7 September 1980 at the 2nd CHOGRM in New Delhi, India, to signify Malaysia's commitment to South-South Co-operation, in particular Technical Cooperation among Developing Countries (TCDC).


MTCP emphasises the development of human resource through the provision of training in various areas, which are essential for a country's development, such as public administration, good governance, health services, education, sustainable development, agriculture, poverty alleviation, investment promotion, ICT and banking. As of 31 December 2020, 34,400 participants from 14 recipient countries have benefitted from the various programmes offered under MTCP.
